## Thank A Teacher Classroom Grant Application Process

The Decatur County Community Foundation recognizes and supports the improvement of educational opportunities throughout our community through scholarships and grants. In an effort to motivate further learning, the Foundation is now offering the “Thank a Teacher Classroom Grant” opportunity.

These grants recognize that there are times when teachers have innovative classroom ideas, but cannot complete them due to budgetary constraints. This grant process will allow teachers to do those different projects.

- The maximum amount that may be requested is \$400
- Grants are for projects that enhance or supplement the teacher’s curriculum
- Grant requests will be awarded on merit and availability of funds
- One grant per teacher per school year

If you believe your school has a request that fits within the Foundation’s funding scope, the scholarship committee asks you to submit a Classroom Grant Application to the Decatur County Community Foundation by the deadlines below. We will respond in writing to all grant requests.

**Applications must be received by the following dates in order to be considered:**

**October 1 and February 1**
